RESOLUTION

No. 23/8/92-ER.—In pursuance of the decision taken under item 2 of the proceedings of the 3rd meeting of the Brahmaputra Review Board held at Guwahati on 30th July, 1990, the Central Government hereby amends its Resolution, in the then Ministry of Irrigation No. 2(17)/80-FC/460, dated 19th March, 1982, and reconstitutes the said Board with the following members:

- (viii) Chief Minister of Mizoram or a Cabinet Minister duly authorised by him
- (ix) Union Minister/Minister of State for Finance
- (x) Union Minister of State for Water Resources
- (xi) Union Minister/Minister of State for Energy

- (xii) Union Minister/Minister of State for Agriculture

- (xiii) Union Minister/Minister of State for Surface Transport

- (xiv) Secretary,
Ministry of Water Resources,
Govt. of India

- (xv) Chairman,
Central Water Commission

Member-Secretary

- (xvi) Chairman,
Brahmaputra Board.

Member (RM), Central Water Commission, will be a permanent invitee to the meetings of the Board.

The Board will lay down broad policies and oversee the work of the Brahmaputra Board for its efficient functioning.

The Board will frame its own Rules of Business. The headquarters of the Board will be at Guwahati.

The Secretariat assistance to the Board will be provided by the Chairman of the Brahmaputra Board, Guwahati.

ORDER

ORDERED that a copy of this Resolution be communicated to the concerned States Union Territories, the Private Secretary and Military Secretary to the President, Prime Minister Office, Comptroller and Auditor General of India, Planning Commission and the Ministries of Power and Non-Conventional Energy Sources (Department of Power), Agriculture, Surface Transport, Finance (Department of Expenditure), Home Affairs, Railways, Urban Development, for information.

NOTE: The Principal constitution of the Brahmaputra Review Board was published in the Gazette of India, Part-I, Section 1 dated 24-4-1982 at pages 379 and 386 vide Resolution of the Government of India in the Ministry of Irrigation No. 2(17)/80-FC/460 dated 19-3-1982.

ORDERED also that the Resolution be published in the Gazette of India and the State Governments concerned may be requested to publish it in the State Gazette for general information.
