A report on erosion of River Barak at Silchar, Assam-anti-erosion measures :

Brahmaputra Board has not proposed/taken any anti erosion schemes in Barak Valley area. Such type of works are carried out by Government of Assam under Flood Management Programme (FMP) scheme funded by Government of India, which is monitored by Brahmaputra Board.

For taking up any anti erosion scheme by Brahmaputra Board in Barak Valley, proposal/request from Government of Assam is required. Based on such a request, Brahmaputra Board may frame schemes and submit to Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation for approval. After getting approval from Government of India such schemes can be executed by Board.
