Measures to be taken by Brahmaputra Board on "Brahmaputra Erosion Permanent Protection Demand Committee, Morigaon, Assam"

The schemes for protection against erosion by the river Brahmaputra are generally prepared and implemented by the concerned state Government. Brahmaputra Board recommends such schemes of state Governments for funding by the Government of India after receiving proposal for taking up under FMP of MoWR, RD&GR as per guidelines on the subject. At present, no such proposal or any other proposal relating to the area mentioned in the referred letter is pending in Brahmaputra Board. Brahmaputra Board may take up specific scheme for erosion protection on receipt of request from the state Government and approval of the Government of India.
