1.1.2 Location of work: As stated in Annexure-I & II above in Majuli Island, Jorhat district, Assam.

1.1.3 General features and major components of the work are as under:

Casting and supplying of RCC (1:2:4) porcupine bars of size 0.10x0.10x3.00m reinforced by 4 nos. 8mm dia TMT bar with stirrup of galvanized wire 4mm dia at 15cm c/c, holes of 20mm dia 50cm inside from both ends at the same face and in other face of post, another 2 nos. of holes of size 20mm dia at 65 cm inside from the both ends cured properly and complete in all respect (RCC porcupine members are to be delivered to the Stock-yards near the laying site/ sites as directed by the department).

1.1.4 Work shall be executed according to General Conditions of Contract for CPWD Form- 8 & 9. The bidder may see the General Conditions of Contract for CPWD Form- 8 & 9 in the office of the Chief Engineer (I&W) during office hours.

SECTION-II

2.0.0 INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

2.1.0 GENERAL

- 2.1.1 Letter of transmittal and forms for deciding eligibility are given in Section-III.
- 2.1.2 All information called for in the enclosed forms should be furnished against the relevant columns in the forms. If for any reason, information is furnished on a separate sheet, this fact should be mentioned against the relevant column. Even if no information is to be provided in a column, a “nil” or “no such case” entry should be made in that column. If any particulars/ query is not applicable in case of the bidder, it should be stated as “not applicable”. The bidders are cautioned that not giving complete information called for in the application forms or not giving it in clear terms or making any change in the prescribed forms, or, deliberately suppressing the information may result in the bid being summarily disqualified. Bids made by telegram or telex or those received late will not be entertained.
- 2.1.3 The bid should be type written in bidder’s letterhead. The bidder should sign each page of the Tender documents.
- 2.1.4 Overwriting should be avoided. Correction, if any, should be made by neatly crossing out, initialing, dating and rewriting. Pages of the eligibility criteria document are numbered. Additional sheets, if any added by the contactor, should be in bidder’s letterhead, numbered and signed by him. They should be submitted as a package with signed letter of transmittal.
- 2.1.5 Reference, information and certificates from the respective clients certifying suitability, technical knowledge or capability of the bidder should be signed by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent.
- 2.1.6 The bidder may furnish any additional information which he thinks is necessary to establish his capabilities to successfully complete the envisaged work. He is, however, advised not to furnish superfluous information. No information shall be entertained after submission of eligibility criteria document unless it is called for by the Employer.
- 2.1.7 Any information furnished by the bidder found to be incorrect either immediately or at a later date, would render him liable to be debarred from tendering/ taking up of work in Brahmaputra Board.
- 2.1.8 A pre-bid conference will be held on **23-02-2011** with the intending bidders for clarification of any doubts of the intending bidders or for modification on any condition of the contract, specifications, etc. Minutes of the meeting will be circulated to all bidders.

2.2.0 DEFINITIONS:

2.2.1 In this document the following words and expressions have the meaning hereby assigned to them.

2.2.2 “BOARD” shall mean the Brahmaputra Board, Ministry of Water Resources, Government of India, with Head quarter at Basistha, Guwahati, Pin Code No. 781029, Assam.

The Brahmaputra Board is a statutory Body set up by Government of India in Dec’1981 under Brahmaputra Board Act. 1980 (Act 46 of 1980) with the object of preparing Master Plan for control of floods and bank erosion and improvement of drainage in the Brahmaputra and Barak Valley for irrigation, generation of Hydropower, navigation and other beneficial purpose.

The Board has multi-disciplinary functions. The jurisdiction of Board covers Brahmaputra River and its tributaries in all the North Eastern States including Sikkim & North Bengal.

In this document Board shall mean competent officers of Board.

2.2.3 “Employer” means the President of India acting through the Chief Engineer (I&W), Brahmaputra Board.

2.2.4 “Bidder” means the individual, proprietary firm, firm in partnership, limited company private or public or corporation.

2.2.5 “Year” means “Financial Year” unless stated otherwise.

2.3.0 METHOD OF APPLICATION

2.3.1 If the bidder is an individual, the application shall be signed by him above his full type written name and current postal address.

2.3.2 If the bidder is a proprietary firm, the application shall be signed by the proprietor above his full type written name and the full name of his firm with its current postal address.

2.3.3 If the bidder is a firm in partnership, the application shall be signed by all the partners of the firm above their full typewritten names and current postal addresses, or, alternately, by a partner holding power of attorney for the firm. In the later case a certified copy of the power of attorney should accompany the application. In both cases a certified copy of the partnership deed and current postal address of all the partners of the firm should accompany the application.

2.3.4 If the bidder is a limited company or a corporation, the application shall be signed by a duly authorized person holding the power of attorney for signing the application accompanied by a copy of the power of attorney. The bidder should also furnish a copy of the Memorandum of Articles of Association duly attested by a Public Notary.

2.3.5 Application supported by prescribed forms and the financial bid shall be placed in separate envelopes and marked as ‘Eligibility documents’, ‘Pre-qualification bid’ and ‘Financial bid’ separately. The three envelopes should be submitted together in another sealed

envelope subscribing “Name of the work: Casting and Supplying of RCC (1:2:4) porcupine bars of size 0.10x0.10x3.00m”. The same will be received by the Chief Engineer (I&W) up to 3-00 p.m. on **28-02-2011** and the Eligibility documents will be opened on the same day at 3-30 p.m. and the Pre-qualification bid of the eligible bidders will be opened on **15-03-2011** at 3-30 p.m. or as notified in presence of intending bidders/ authorized representative. The time and date of opening of Financial bid of Pre-qualified bidders will be communicated at a later date. The Earnest Money and cost of Tender paper (Bidder who has not paid the cost already) will be enclosed with the envelope containing the eligibility criteria document in absence of which, the other two envelopes will not be opened.

2.3.6 The bidders are advised to go through the detailed terms & conditions of CPWD Form-8&9 which may be seen in the Technical Branch of Chief Engineer (I&W).

2.4.0 Final Decision Making Authority

The employer reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to annul the process and reject all bids at any time, without assigning any reason or incurring any liability to the bidders.

2.5.0 Particulars Provisional

The particulars of the work given in Section-I are provisional and must be considered only as advance information to assist bidders.

2.6.0 Site Visit

The bidder is advised to visit the site of work, at his own cost, and examine it and its surroundings by himself to collect all information that he considers necessary for proper assessment of the prospective assignment & also to quote rate for different items of the works/ supply according to site conditions etc. No claim for enhancement of rate over the quoted rate on the plea of adverse site condition, etc will be entertained later on.

2.7.0 INITIAL CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

The initial criteria prescribed in Para 2.7.1 to 2.7.9 below will be scrutinized at first and then the bidder’s eligibility for the work will be determined. Bidders are required to fulfill all the initial criteria for eligibility to become eligible for consideration of financial bid.

2.7.1 The bidder should have satisfactorily completed two works each costing 60% of the estimated cost put to tender, or one work costing 80% of the estimated cost put to tender of the following nature during the last five years ending last day of the month previous to one in which the applications are invited.

This should be certified by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer/ Project Manager or equivalent in case of Govt. supplier.

(Similar work means Casting and Supplying of RCC porcupine bars. In case of works for combined item of casting & laying of RCC porcupine, the cost of the work will be considered by multiplying with a factor of **(5.7/6.7)**).

2.7.2 The bidder should have had average **annual financial turnover (gross) not less than 50%** of the estimated cost put to tender during the immediate last 3 (three) consecutive financial years. The average annual financial turnover (gross) should be duly audited by a Chartered Accountant. Year in which no turnover is shown also be considered for working out the average.

2.7.3 The bidder should not have incurred any loss in more than two years during the immediate last five consecutive financial years, duly certified by the Chartered Accountant.

Duly certified balance sheet, profit & loss account, profit & loss appropriation account and comparative income statement of the bidder should be included for last 5 years.

- 2.7.4 The **bidding capacity** of the contractor should be equal to or more than the estimated cost of the supply work put to tender. The bidding capacity shall be worked out by the following formula.

$$\text{Bidding Capacity} = (A \times N \times 2) - B$$

Where-

A= Maximum value of works executed in one year during the last five years taking into account the completed as well as works in progress (to be supplied in Form-C).

B= Value of existing commitments and ongoing works to be completed during the period of completion of work for which bids have been invited (to be submitted in Form-D & Statement-I).

N= Number of years prescribed for completion of the work for which this bid is invited.

The bidders are required to submit the details of works, etc. in Statement-1 & Form-C & D appended in the Section III for calculating the values of A& B.

- 2.7.5 The bidder should have a **solvency of the amount equal to 40%** of the estimated cost of the supply work put to tender. (Form-B, Para 3.1.2)
- 2.7.6 The bidder should produce a **Performance Certificate** in sealed cover from any Govt. department for a quantity of 10% of the tendered quantity for supply of RCC porcupine in any year supplied during last 5 years. (Form-E, Para 3.1.6).
(Govt. department means Govt. of India or any State Govt/ Govt. undertaking within India.)
- 2.7.7 The bidder should submit up-to-date Income Tax Clearance Certificate/ PAN, Permission for Composition Amount of VAT in WC-2 form/ VAT Registration Certificate, EPF Registration Certificate.
- 2.7.8 The bidder should have sufficient number of Technical and Administrative employees for the proper execution of the contract. The bidder should submit a list of these employees stating clearly how these would be involved in this work.
- 2.7.9 The bidder should have own construction equipment as per list (Form-H) required for the proper and timely execution of the work. Else, he should certify that he would be able to manage the equipment by hiring, etc. and submit the list of firms from whom he proposes to hire. The bidder should have the following equipment, -
- (a) Concrete Mixer Machine = 2 nos.
 - (b) Vibrator = 4 nos.
 - (c) Water Pump set = 2 set
 - (d) Diesel Generating set = 1 no.

2.8.0 EVALUATION CRITERIA OF PRE-QUALIFICATION BID

- 2.8.1 The details submitted by the bidder will be evaluated in the following manner,-
- 2.8.2 The initial criteria for eligibility prescribed in Para. 2.7.1 to 2.7.9 above in respect of experience of similar class of work competed, bidding capacity and financial turnover, etc. will first be scrutinized and the bidder's eligibility for the work be determined.

2.8.3 The bidders qualifying the initial criteria, as set out in para.2.7.1 to 2.7.9 under Section-II, will be evaluated for the following criteria by scoring method on the basis of details furnished by them.

E. Personal & Establishment (Form: F & Form: G)	:- 10 marks
E. Plant & Equipment (Form: H)	:- 15 marks
Total :- 100 marks	

To become eligible for participating in financial bid, the bidders must secure at least 50(fifty) percent marks in each and 60(sixty) percent marks in aggregate. The department, however, reserves the right to restrict the list of such qualified contractors/ bidders to any number deemed suitable by it.

2.8.4 Even though any bidder may satisfy the above requirements, he would be liable to disqualification if he has:

- a) made misleading or false representation or deliberately suppressed the information in the forms, statements and enclosures required in the eligibility criteria document,
- b) record of poor performance such as abandoning work, not properly completing the contract, or financial failures/ weakness, etc.

2.8.5 Financial Information

Bidder should furnish the Annual Financial Statement for the last five year in Form: A and Solvency Certificate in Form: B. (Ref. Section-III for Form-A & Form-B.)

2.8.6 Experience in works highlighting experience in Similar Works

2.8.6.1 Bidder should furnish the following: -

(a) List of all works of similar nature successfully completed during last five years in Form: C & (b) List of the projects under execution or awarded in Form: D.

2.8.6.2 Particulars of completed works and performance of the bidder duly authenticated/ certified by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent should be furnished separately for each work completed or in progress in Form: E.

2.8.6.3 Information in Form: D should be complete and no work should be left out.

2.8.7 Organization Information

Bidder is required to submit the information in respect of his organization in Forms: F & G.

2.8.8 Letter of Transmittal

The bidder should submit the letter of transmittal attached with the document.

2.8.9 Opening of Financial Bid

After evaluation of applications, a list of qualified and technically acceptable bidders will be prepared. Thereafter, the financial bids of only the qualified and technically acceptable bidders shall be opened at the notified time, date and place in the presence of the qualified bidders or their representatives. The validity of the tenders shall be reckoned from the date of opening of the financial bids.

2.8.10 Award Criteria

The employer reserves the right, without being liable for any damages or obligation to inform the bidder to: (a) Amend the scope and value of contract of the bidder, (b) Reject any or all the applications without assigning any reason thereof.

2.8.11 Any effort on the part of the bidder or his agent to exercise influence or to pressurize the employer would result in rejection of his bid. Canvassing of any kind is prohibited.
